

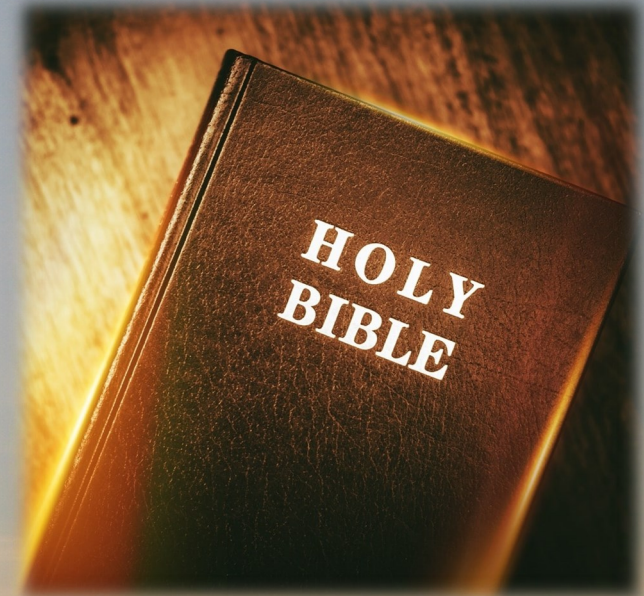
We thought of you with
