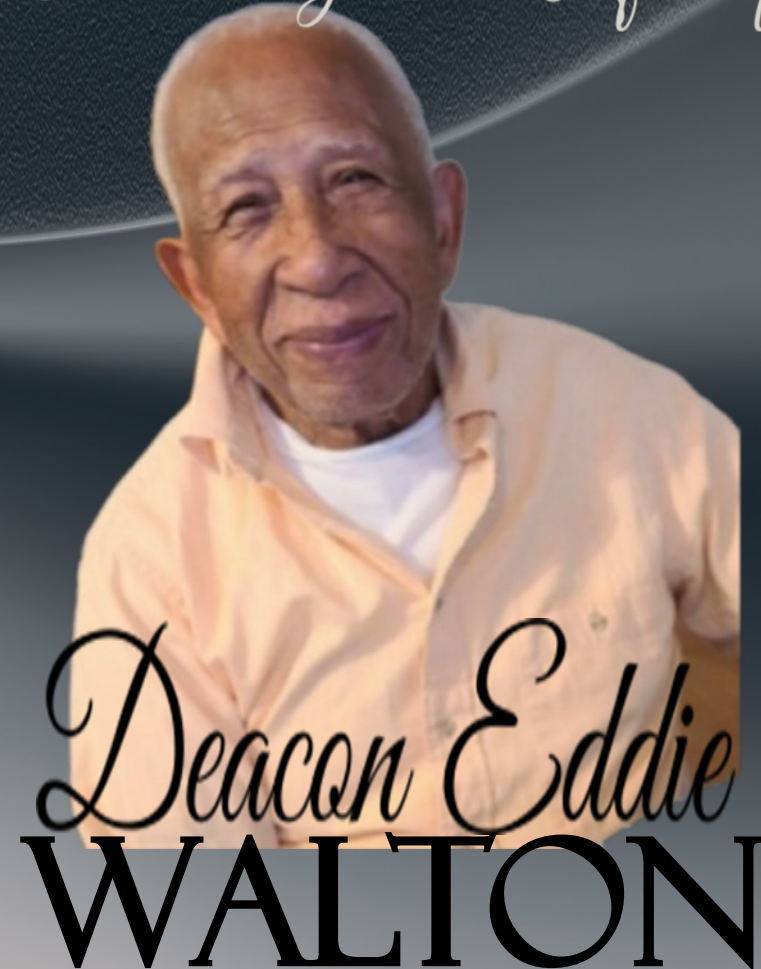

# Remembering Deacon Eddie Walton
